



SpringerLink の利用方法

(学認を利用して学外からアクセスする場合)


1. SpringerLink にアクセスし、画面右上の「Sign up / Log in」から「Institutional / Athens login」をクリック。



2. 「Or, find your institution (via Shibboleth)」のプルダウンリストから「Miyagi University of Education」を選択。



3. 「Log in via Shibboleth」 ボタンをクリック。




